



NON-RESIDENCY WAIVER

Effective October 1, 2008, as a condition of Coalition On Temporary Shelter (COTS) agreement with the Michigan Department of Human Services (DHS), all applicants for employment, employee, subcontractors, subcontractor employees or volunteers who work directly with clients or who has access to client information must complete a Non-Residency Waiver.

IN CONSIDERATION of being given the opportunity for employment, subcontracting, or volunteering for the Emergency Shelter Program of the COTS, I agree and warrant that execution of this Waiver is a condition of my acceptance of any employment, subcontracting, or volunteering position.
